Deuteronomy 6:4-13 (KJV)

[4] Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:[5] And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.[6] And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:[7] And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt

**talk of them** when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.[8] And thou shalt **bind them for a sign** upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.[9] And thou shalt **write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates**.[10] And it shall be, when the LORD thy God shall have brought thee into the land which he swore unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, **to give thee great and goodly cities, which thou buildedst not,[11] And houses full of all good things, which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not;** when thou shalt have eaten and be full; [12] Then beware lest thou forget the LORD, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.[13] Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God, and serve him, and shalt swear by his name.

**Many Christians never walk in the fullness of their inheritance, you must believe in the promises and receive them in order to walk in them. Just as you must use your faith for salvation, healing, the baptism of the Holy Spirit, the gifts of the Spirit and all the other promises we must use our faith and proclaim supernatural provision!**

**Romans 10:10 (KJV) [10] For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.**

**(heart = believe - mouth = confession) all the promises are received the same way!**

**\*\*Romans 4:13 (KJV) [13] For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.**

**\*\*Romans 4:13 (NLT) [13]** It is clear, then, that God's promise to give the whole earth to Abraham and his descendants was not based on obedience to God's law, but on the new relationship with God that comes by faith.

Romans 8:17 (KJV) [17] And if children, **then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ;** if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

Galatians 3:29 (KJV) [29] And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and **heirs according to the promise.**

**Galatians 4:1-7 (KJV) [1]** Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, **though he be lord of all;** [2] But is under tutors and governors **until the time** appointed of the father. [3] Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world:[4] But when the fulness of **the time was come,** God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, [5] To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. [6] And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. [7] Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then **an heir of God through Christ.**

Hebrews 1:2 (KJV)[2] Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

**Joshua 21:43-45** (NLT) [43] So the LORD gave to Israel all the land he had sworn to give their ancestors, and they conquered it and settled there. [44] And the LORD gave them rest on every side, just as he had solemnly promised their ancestors. None of their enemies could stand against them, for the LORD helped them conquer all their enemies. [45] **All of the good promises that the LORD had given Israel came true.**

Joshua 21:45 (AMP) [45] There failed no part of any good thing which the Lord had promised to the house of Israel; all came to pass.

Genesis 22:13-14 (NIV) [13] Abraham **looked** up and there in a thicket he **saw** a ram caught by its horns. **He went over and took the ram and sacrificed it** as a burnt offering instead of his son. [14] So Abraham **called that place The LORD Will Provide.** And to this day it is said, "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided."

Exodus 3:1-4 (NIV) [1] Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the desert and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. [2] There the angel of the LORD appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. **Moses saw** that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up. [3] So Moses thought, "**I will go over and see** this strange sight—why the bush does not burn up." [4] **When the LORD saw** that he had gone over to look, God called to him from within the bush, "Moses! Moses!" And Moses said, "Here I am."

[5] He shall receive blessing from the Lord and righteousness from the God of his salvation. [6] This is the generation [description] of those who seek Him [who inquire of and for Him and of necessity require Him], who seek Your face, [O God of] Jacob. Selah [pause, and think of that]!

Psalms 119:30-32 (NIV) [30] I have chosen the way of truth; I have set my heart on your laws. [31] I hold fast to your statutes, O LORD; do not let me be put to shame. [32] I run in the path of your commands, for you have set my heart free.

2 Samuel 22:21-22 (NIV) [21] "The LORD has dealt with me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands he has rewarded me. [22] For I have kept the ways of the LORD; I have not done evil by turning from my God.

Matthew 5:8 (KJV) [8] Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

**Many are trying to use grace as a grease to slide by in church and slip into heaven but they will come with road rash from the highway to hell! Many Christians lock themselves out of the blessings through tainted hearts and dirty hands!**

1 Corinthians 10:26 (AMP) [26] For the [whole] earth is the Lord's and everything that is in it. [Ps 24:1; 50:12.]

Psalms 50:12 (KJV) [12] If I were hungry, I would not tell thee: for the world is mine, and the fulness thereof.

Deuteronomy 10:14 (KJV) [14] Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is the LORD'S thy God, the earth also, with all that therein is.

1 Samuel 15:22 (KJV) [22] And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.

## God's transformation of supernatural provision!

Ecclesiastes 2:24-26 (KJV) [24] ¶ There is nothing better for a man, than that he should eat and drink, and that he should make his soul enjoy good in his labour. This also I saw, that it was from the hand of God. [25] For who can eat, or who else can hasten hereunto, more than I? [26] For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and **to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God.** This also is vanity and vexation of spirit.

Job 27:16-17 (NIV)[16] Though he heaps up silver like dust and clothes like piles of clay,[17] what he lays up the righteous will wear, and the innocent will divide his silver.

Proverbs 13:22 (NIV) [22] A good man leaves an inheritance for his children's children, but a sinner's wealth is stored up for the righteous.

Esther 8:1-2 (NIV) [1] That same day King Xerxes gave Queen Esther the estate of Haman, the enemy of the Jews. And Mordecai came into the presence of the king, for Esther had told how he was related to her. [2] The king took off his signet ring, which he had reclaimed from Haman, and presented it to Mordecai. And Esther appointed him over Haman's estate.

Genesis 41:42-43 (NIV) [42] Then Pharaoh took his signet ring from his finger and put it on Joseph's finger. He dressed him in robes of fine linen and put a gold chain around his neck. [43] He had him ride in a chariot as his second-in-command, and men shouted before him, "Make way!" Thus he put him in charge of the whole land of Egypt.

Daniel 2:48-49 (NIV) [48] Then the king placed Daniel in a high position and lavished many gifts on him. He made him ruler over the entire province of Babylon and placed him in charge of all its wise men. [49] Moreover, at Daniel's request the king appointed Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego administrators over the province of Babylon, while Daniel himself remained at the royal court.

Hebrews 7:22 (KJV) [22] By so much was Jesus made a surety of a better testament.

Hebrews 8:6 (KJV) [6] But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon **better promises**.

**Promises** = A primary preposition properly meaning **superimposition** (of time, place, order, etc.), **as a relation of distribution** [with the genitive case], that is, over, upon, etc.; of rest (with the dative case) at, on, etc.; of direction (with the accusative case) towards, upon, etc.. In compounds it retains essentially the same import, at, upon , etc. (literally or figuratively).

Psalms 107:19-20 (KJV) [19] Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses.[20] He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Psalms 107:31-38 (KJV) [31] Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! [32] Let them exalt him also in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders. [33] He turneth rivers into a wilderness, and the watersprings into dry ground; [34] A fruitful land into barrenness, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein. [35] He turneth the wilderness into a standing water, and dry ground into watersprings. [36] And there he maketh

the hungry to dwell, that they may prepare a city for habitation; [37] And sow the fields, and plant vineyards, which may yield fruits of increase. [38] He blesseth them also, so that they are multiplied greatly; and suffereth not their cattle to decrease.

Psalms 107:42-43 (KJV) [42] The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. [43] Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD.

Matthew 17:20 (KJV) [20] And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

Matthew 19:26 (KJV) [26] But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible..

Luke 12:21 (KJV) [21] So is he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God. **(Is a fool)**

### **Jesus teaching about kingdom living, Marriage, Receiving literally like little children, Mammon & Supernatural Provision,**

**Mark 10:23-27** (KJV) [23] ¶ And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God! [24] And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God! [25] It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God. [26] And they were astonished out of measure, saying

among themselves, Who then can be saved? [27] And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men it is impossible, but not with God: for **with God all things are possible.** [28] ¶ Then Peter began to say unto him, Lo, we have left all, and have followed thee.[29] And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's,[30] **But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time,** houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life. [31] But many that are **first** shall be **last**; and the **last first.**

**First, Proud** = 4413. πρώτος pro tós, pro'-tos; of 4253; foremost (in importance). best, chief first.4253. πρό pró, pro; A primary preposition; "fore", that is, in front of, prior (figuratively superior) to.

**Last, Humble** = 2078. ἐσχάτος esxatós, es'-khat-os; A superlative probably from 2192 (in the sense of contiguity); farthest, final (of place or time). :- ends of, last, latter end, lowest, uttermost.

Matthew 20:1-16 (NLT) [1] “For the Kingdom of Heaven is like the owner of an estate who went out early one morning to hire workers for his vineyard. [2] He agreed to pay the normal daily wage and sent them out to work. [3] “At nine o'clock in the morning he was passing through the marketplace and saw some people standing around doing nothing. [4] So he hired them, telling them he would pay them whatever was right at the end of the day. [5] At noon and again around three o'clock he did the same thing. [6] At five o'clock that evening he was in town again and saw some more people standing around. He asked them, ‘Why haven't you been working today?’ [7] “They replied, ‘Because no one hired us.’ “The owner of the estate told them, ‘Then go on out and join the others in my vineyard.’ [8] “That evening he told the foreman to call the workers in and pay them, beginning with the last workers first. [9] When those hired at five o'clock were paid, each received a full day's wage. [10] When those hired earlier came to get their

pay, they assumed they would receive more. But they, too, were paid a day's wage. [11] When they received their pay, they protested, [12] 'Those people worked only one hour, and yet you've paid them just as much as you paid us who worked all day in the scorching heat.' [13] "He answered one of them, 'Friend, I haven't been unfair! Didn't you agree to work all day for the usual wage? [14] Take it and go. I wanted to pay this last worker the same as you. [15] Is it against the law for me to do what I want with my money? Should you be angry because I am kind?' [16] "And so it is, that many who are first now will be last then; and those who are last now will be first then."

Luke 19:26 (KJV) [26] For I say unto you, That unto every one which hath shall be given; and from him that hath not, even that he hath shall be taken away from him.

Matthew 25:14-30 (KJV) [14] ¶ For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods. [15] And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey. [22] He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them.[23] His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.[24] Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:[25] And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.[26] His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:[27] Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.[28] Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents. [29] For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.[30] And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 6:33 (KJV) [33] But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

1 Timothy 6:17 (NIV) [17] Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment.

**How God Transfers wealth! He provides the plan but we must work the plan.**

### **Angelic activity!**

Genesis 24:40 (KJV) [40] And he said unto me, The LORD, before whom I walk, will send his angel with thee, and **prosper thy way**; and thou shalt take a wife for my son of my kindred, and of my father's house:

Psalms 34:7-10 (KJV)[7] The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.[8] O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him. [9] O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for there is no want to them that fear him.[10] The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.

Daniel 3:28 (KJV) [28] Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have **changed the king's word**, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

1 Samuel 16:13 (KJV) [13] Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and **the Spirit of the LORD came upon**

**David from that day forward.** So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

Isaiah 61:1-7 (KJV) [1] **The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me;** because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; [2] To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; [3] To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified. [4] ¶ And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations. [5] And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien shall be your plowmen and your vinedressers.[6] But ye shall be named the Priests of the LORD: men shall call you the **Ministers of our God: ye shall eat the riches of the Gentiles,** and in their glory shall ye boast yourselves.[7] ¶ For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.

John 16:13 (KJV) [13] Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, **he will guide you** into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and **he will shew you things to come.**

1 Corinthians 2:9-10, 12 (KJV) [9] But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. [10] But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

[12] Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; **that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.**

1 Corinthians 12:7 (KJV) [7] But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

## **Wisdom**

1 Kings 10:7 (KJV) [7] Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard. (Queen of Sheba, speaking of Solomon)

Proverbs 3:13-16, 19 (KJV) [13] ¶ Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding. [14] For the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold. [15] She is more precious than rubies: and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her. [16] Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honour. [19] The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath he established the heavens.

Proverbs 4:7 (KJV) [7] Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.

Proverbs 8:12 (KJV) [12] I wisdom dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions.

### **Your Faith and the word of your testimony!**

Proverbs 12:14 (KJV) [14] A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.

Jeremiah 1:4-12 (KJV) [4] Then the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, [5] Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations. Ecclesiastes 5:2-7 (KJV)[2] **Be not rash with thy mouth,** and let not thine heart be hasty to utter any thing before God: for God is in heaven, and thou

upon earth: therefore let thy words be few.[3] **For a dream cometh through the multitude of business;** and a fool's voice is known by multitude of words.[4] When thou vowest a vow unto God, defer not to pay it; for he hath no pleasure in fools: pay that which thou hast vowed.[5] Better is it that thou shouldest not vow, than that thou shouldest vow and not pay.[6] **Suffer not thy mouth to cause thy flesh to sin;** neither say thou before the angel, that it was an error: wherefore should God be angry at thy voice, and destroy the work of thine hands? [7] For in the multitude of dreams and many words there are also divers vanities: but fear thou God.

Mark 11:22-24 (KJV) [22] And Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have faith in God.**[23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall **say unto this mountain,** Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; **he shall have whatsoever he saith.**[24] Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, **believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

Genesis 39:2-3 (KJV) [2] And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian. [3] And his master saw that the LORD was with him, and that **the LORD made all that he did to prosper in his hand.**

Deuteronomy 28:8 (AMP) [8] The Lord shall command the blessing upon you in your storehouse and in all that you undertake. And **He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you.**

Job 36:11 (KJV)[11] If they obey and serve him, **they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.**

Proverbs 3:9-10 (KJV)[9] Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase: [10] So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Proverbs 8:17-21 (KJV) [17] I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.[18] Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness.[19] My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver.[20] I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment:[21] **That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.**

Isaiah 45:3 (KJV) [3] **And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places,** that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.

Psalms 35:27 (KJV) [27] Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, **Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.**

Jeremiah 33:9 (KJV)[9] ¶ And it shall be to me a name of joy, a praise and an honour before all the nations of the earth, which shall hear all the good that I do unto them: and they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and **for all the prosperity that I procure unto it.**

Malachi 3:10-12 (KJV)

[10] **Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse**, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not **open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.** [11] And **I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes**, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. [12] **And all nations shall call you blessed:** for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.

Matthew 17:24-27 (KJV) [24] ¶ And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received tribute money came to Peter, and said, Doth not your master pay tribute?[25] He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?[26] Peter saith unto him, Of strangers. Jesus saith unto him, Then are the children free.[27] Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee. **(Taxes)**

3 John 2-4 (KJV)[2] Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest **prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.**[3] For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.[4] **I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.**
